Weekly Contract agreement

Rates: \$55.00 first child/ \$50.00 each additional child

Time: after school as well as early release days until 6:30 PM

When: Starting Monday, August 13th- May 25th

Payments: Due by the Friday of each week

Hourly agreement

Rates: \$5.00 per child for each hour (including partial hours)

Time: after school as well as early release days until 6:30 PM

When: Starting Monday August 13th- May 24th

Payments- Due on the date of service

• EXTRA FEES

***There is a \$30.00 returned check fee. After one returned check, all payments must be made in cash.**

*** There is a late fee of \$10.00 each week for any account not paid in full by the Friday of the week of services.(If there is no school on Friday, payments are due on Thursday.)**

***If your child is not picked up by 6:30, you will also pay a late pick up charge of \$10.00 per child in addition to \$1.00 per minute per child that he/she is late in being picked up.**

***Tutoring is available for an additional \$25.00 per hour.**

Washington Park Elementary School Code of Conduct

Students will be expected to adhere to the school code of conduct. Any instances of hitting, bullying, stealing, not following directions, or other types of poor behavior will result in a “strike” which follows with a one day suspension from Camp WP. A second strike follows with a two day suspension from Camp WP. Three strikes result in no longer being able to attend Camp WP. It is also understood that severe behavior instances result in the end of camp services for that child.

Parents you will be notified on paper at the time of pick up if your child receives a strike so you are aware of the situation. We want to work together to make sure all students have a safe, fun, positive camp experience.

Pick up Policy:

For security purposes, any person picking up your child must be on your list of approved people who can pick up your child as well as have proof of identity.

Children must be signed out each day when leaving camp as well as the time recorded.

Medications:

Administration of medications will be performed by camp staff in parents give the medicine as well as a signed written directive indicating dose and time of administration. All prescription medicines must be in the pharmacy bottle with the child’s name and dosage on it.

Should a child become ill, the staff will attempt to make phone contact with parent(s) then emergency contact. For emergency situations requiring immediate medical attention, Jasper County Rescue will be contacted and transport will be made to the hospital as stated from the Jasper County Rescue at that time.

Tutoring:

If you wish to sign your child up for tutoring, please let staff at Camp WP know. We will contact a certified Teacher who is ready to work one on one with your child in the areas you or your child’s teacher say are most needed. You can work with that teacher as to time, date, and frequency of tutoring.
