

Logging into JCPS & into Classlink (Access to All JCPS Tech Programs) (Access to All JCPS Tech Programs)

Step 1: Click "Next" when the "Sign in to your Chromebook" message first appears. A "Sign in to Classlink" page will appear.

Step 2: Students should log in using their Quick Card provided by their teacher.

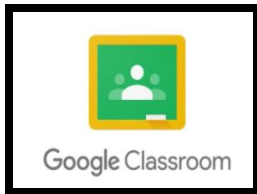

Access the following apps using the Classlink Login Information

REQUIRED Technology Programs Used During Virtual Instruction

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Google Classroom (Google Meets), i-Ready (Reading & Math), and Reading Horizons (Phonics) will be used during virtual instruction. Daily schedules and each teacher's Google Meets Link can be found in their Google Classroom. i-Ready Reading (30 mins. a day) and i-Ready Math (30 mins. a day) will provide independent practice for all students when they are not participating in whole group or small group lessons with their teacher. Reading Horizons (20 mins. a day) will provide practice on phonics skills for students. These apps are all accessible through Classlink. Students will click on the app icon, and they will be automatically logged into the app.



****Google Classroom-** In the event that our school district has to move to virtual learning, our students will use Google Classroom to access lessons, meet with their teacher for whole group and small group lessons, and complete assignments. At times, students will be working in Google Classroom at school as well to become familiar with the platform.



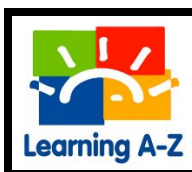
****i-Ready (Reading & Math)-** Students will use i-Ready to practice reading and math skills. i-Ready is adaptive for students and provides instructional practice based on their progress in both reading and math.



****Reading Horizons-** Students will use the Reading Horizons app to practice their phonics skills. The app provides instruction based on their progress in the software.

OPTIONAL Technology Programs

Students will not be required to use the following programs during virtual learning. Some teachers may choose to use the supplemental programs listed for additional practice for students. Your child can access any of the programs listed below for additional practice by clicking on the app icon.



Learning A-Z- Learning A-Z includes Headsprout for Kindergarten students and RAZ Plus & Writing A-Z for 1st and 2nd grade students. Headsprout instruction builds foundational reading skills. RAZ Plus & Writing A-Z includes reading and writing practice for 1st and 2nd grade students as well as a leveled library for students to read and listen to books on their reading level.



Reflex Math- Reflex Math provides math fact fluency practice with addition and subtraction facts through 10.
