Definitions

Symptomatic- showing symptoms

Asymptomatic-showing NO symptoms



JCCS RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN AFTER COVID 19 OR EXPOSURE

July 22,2020

Symptomatic persons with confirmed COVID-19 or suspected COVID-19 can return to school/work after:

- At least three days (72 hours) have passed without fever
- AND
- Improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath)
- AND
- At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared



JCCS RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN AFTER COVID 19 OR EXPOSURE

Asymptomatic persons with confirmed COVID-19 can return to school/work after:

- At least ten (10) days have passed since the positive laboratory test

AND

- The person remains asymptomatic



JCCS RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN AFTER COVID 19 OR EXPOSURE

July 22,2020

Asymptomatic persons who have a known exposure to a person with COVID-19 **without appropriate PPE** can return to school after quarantine for fourteen (14) calendar days from last known exposure date.

General Definitions of Known Exposure:

- Living in the same household as a sick person with COVID-19
- Caring for a sick person with COVID-19
- Being within 6 feet of a sick person with COVID-19 for about 15 minutes
- Being in direct contact with secretions from a sick person with COVID-19 (e.g., being coughed on, kissing, sharing utensils, etc.)
