

FREE MEALS FOR KIDS



The Jasper County Charter System would like to offer all students, including those in virtual learning, as well as any child aged 0-18 in our County, meals at no cost. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) is allowing School Nutrition Programs to offer meals at no cost to children across our Nation **until the end of December 2020 OR until USDA runs out of money allocated for this purpose, whichever comes first**. Any money you have paid for lunch since September 1, 2020 will be credited to your child's account, so they will be set when we return to normal paid/free/reduced statuses in January.

All children attending in-person classes will receive meals at no cost immediately, beginning October 7, 2020. Meals will be available to children in our community on buses from 11:00AM - 12:15PM located at:

- Shiloh Baptist Church at Hwy 142, Recreation Parking Lot
- Jackson Lake Fire Station
- Funderburg Park Pavillion
- North Alcovy Fire Station off of County Line Road

Dates for bus pick up in October 2020:

7th, 14th, 19th, 21st, 26th, and 28th
