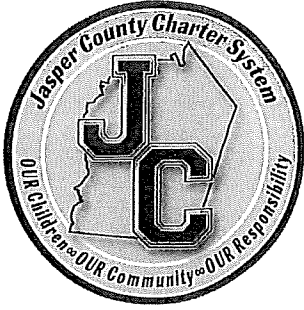

Jasper County Charter System MAP Goals for 2021-2022

LITERACY

District GOAL- By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCCS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring average, high average, and high in Reading on the MAP Assessment will increase from 62% to 66% on the Spring MAP 2022.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCPS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring average, high average, and high in Reading on the MAP Assessment will increase from 66% to 68% on the Spring MAP 2022 Assessment.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **WPES** will increase the percentage average of students scoring average, high average, and high in Reading on the MAP Assessment will increase from 60% to 65% on the Spring MAP 2022 Assessment.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCMS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring average, high average, and high in Reading on the MAP Assessment will increase from 56% to 65% on the Spring MAP 2022 Assessment.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCHS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring average, high average, and high in Reading on the MAP Assessment will increase to 67%.

MATHEMATICS

District GOAL- By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCCS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring high average, and high in Math on the MAP Assessment will increase from 27% to 34% on the Spring MAP 2022.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCPS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring, high average, and high in Math on the MAP Assessment will increase from 40% to 43% on the Spring MAP 2022 Assessment.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **WPES** will increase the percentage average of students scoring high average, and high in Math on the MAP Assessment will increase from 24% to 33% on the Spring MAP 2022 Assessment.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCMS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring high average, and high in Math on the MAP Assessment will increase from 20% to 30% on the Spring MAP 2022 Assessment.

By the end of the 2021-2022 school year **JCHS** will increase the percentage average of students scoring high average, and high in Math on the MAP Assessment will increase to 37% on the Spring MAP 2022 Assessment.

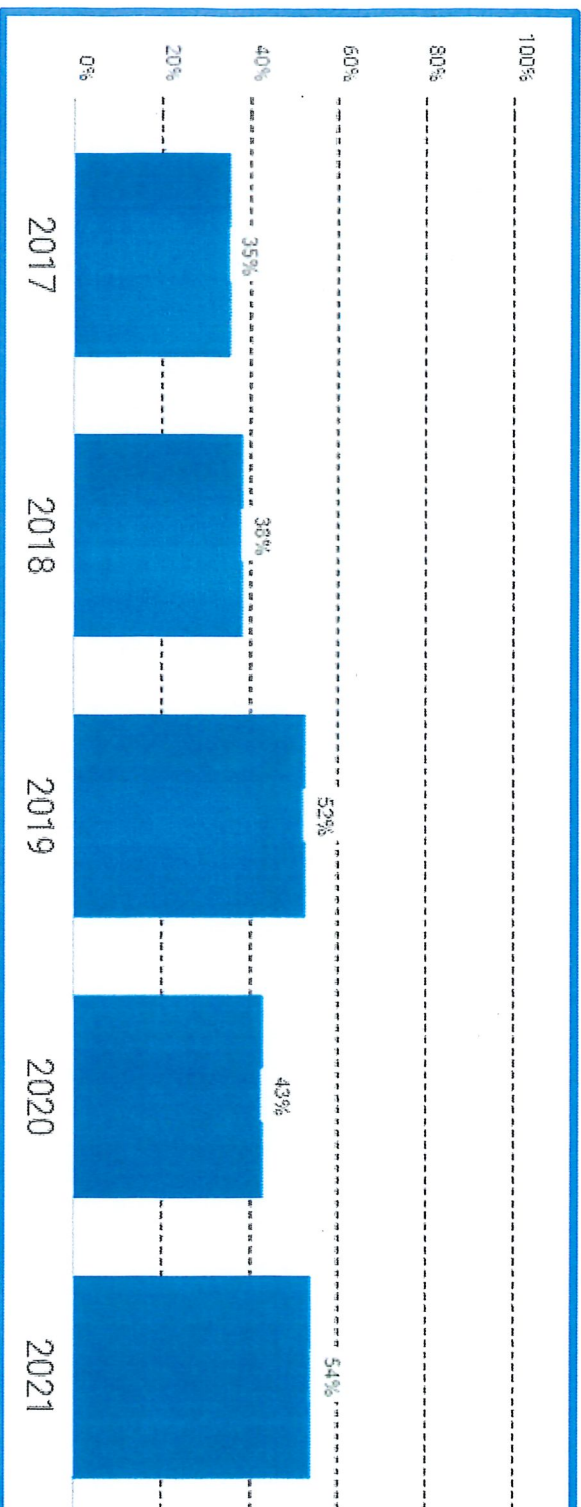
